

Brothers and Sisters.

I have been asked numerous times lately about membership dues. Memberships drive our lodge! If it weren't for our members, we wouldn't have one that's obvious, but let me review what is needed for new and renewal of memberships. First, we need new members. A sponsor gives the prospective member an application. It is the responsibility of both to fill out the application form correctly. There are parts that both sponsor and applicant need to fill out. The applicant then needs to pay \$80. \$20 is for the application fee and the remaining \$60 is for their membership. This payment and application should be put in the LOOM mailbox in the social quarters.

Once these are received by our Administrator and Treasurer, the membership is then voted upon at the next general meeting. It may take a few weeks for the new member to get their card so it is important for the new member to keep the receipt portion of the application.

Renewal of memberships can be done yearly or for three years. Each yearly renewal is \$60. The benefit for renewing for three years is that IF DONE AT OUR LODGE (not online), a membership will only cost \$120 not \$180. You get one year for free!

When submitting your payment for renewal, please put the name of the member and the membership number at minimum on your submission. This should also go into the LOOM mailbox.

You can renew for three years online, however you will not get a free year so it will cost you \$180.

As for the Legion and WOTM, their dues are \$15/year. ONLY the WOTM does the three years for the cost of two (only if paying at the lodge). Now if you expire you are required to pay your arrearage then the amount of dues you want from that point (one or three years). There are instances in which a member lets their membership expire for a greater time but wants to renew. Please come see an officer and we will help you go through the steps to get your membership reinstated correctly. I hope this helps!
